

# NYSE Managed File Transfer (MFT)

## Introduction

NYSE MFT is NYSE Group's secure transfer protocol. Most NYSE Pillar equities and options transaction reports are transmitted via MFT.

## Account Setup

To receive MFT reports, an MFT account must be created by submitting a request here. The following information is required: Firm Name, CRD#, Business Contact (Name, Email, Phone), Technical Contact (Name, E-mail, Phone), IP Information. One account per firm provides access to all NYSE MFT files.
